Private lessons

Insanely Busy lessons are sold in a package of twelve 30 minute sessions. All twelve lessons must be completed within six months of your first lesson. Lessons are offered in the day and evening Monday through Saturday. Private lessons can be arranged for any instrument and start at any time during the year.
