APRIL/MAY

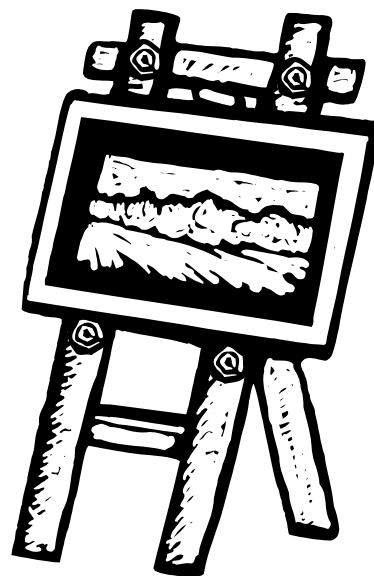
Painting for Kids (Grades 4-8)
