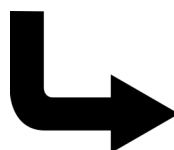

GROUP WEEK FAQ's:

- Q. Who goes to Group Week Classes?** A. All private and partner lesson students.
- Q. What will my student learn?** A. Classes include playing for peers, music listening and appreciation, music history, and music theory.
- Q. Core class versus Specialty class?** A. All students take a Core class each Group Week. Specialty class offerings vary during the school year. Students can take as many Specialty classes as desired. Ask at the studio or see our website for more information.
- Q. Are Group Week classes mandatory?** A. Yes. They are included in tuition and programmed to enhance private lessons.
- Q. Are missed Group Week classes refunded?** A. We are not able to offer refunds for missed Group Week classes.
- Q. Can Group Week class be made up?** A. We're not able to do make ups. Students can join a different Core class if needed.
- Q. Why Group Weeks?** A. Research shows that students can benefit immensely from group learning. Classes build community and promote idea sharing and creativity. Curriculum builds on private lessons.
